

Olympic and Other Games

It seems not inappropriate to mention here the other celebrated national games of the Greeks. The first and most distinguished were the Olympic, founded it was said by Zeus himself. They were celebrated at Olympia in Elis. Vast numbers of spectators flocked to them from every part of Greece, and from Asia, Africa, and Sicily. They were repeated every fifth year in midsummer, and continued for five days. They gave rise to the custom of reckoning time and dating events by Olympiads. The first Olympiad is generally considered as corresponding with the year 776 B.C. The Pythian games were celebrated in the vicinity of Delphi, the Isthmian on the Corinthian isthmus, the Nemean at Nemea, a city of Argolis.

The exercises in these games were of five sorts: running, leaping, wrestling, throwing the quoit, and hurling the javelin, or boxing. Besides these exercises of bodily strength and agility, there were contests in music, poetry, and eloquence. Thus these games furnished poets, musicians, and authors the best opportunities to present their productions to the public, and the fame of the victors was diffused far and wide.

Education Committee

To plan programs which provide beneficial information of interest to the membership, plan special events to emphasize our Greek heritage, and to prepare programs that will assist our youth in furthering their education. Such efforts shall include obtaining speakers on a variety of subjects, coordinating with the Hellenic Foundation on programs, sponsoring scholarship programs, and other events of interest to the membership.

Public Relations Committee

To be responsible for providing all the necessary date for release that will enhance the Society's image and position with both the Greek Community and the Greater Columbus area. Responsible for preparation of all data released to support events sponsored by the Society. COORDINATE with all other COMMITTEES to assure the maximum dissemination of information.

Parliamentarian

The duties of the Parliamentarian are to maintain the By-laws of the Society and assist in the interpretation and implementation of the By-laws

CONSTITUTION AND BY LAWS OF THE GREEK OLYMPIC SOCIETY

ARTICLE I NAME AND LOCATION

The Greek Olympic Society organized in the City of Columbus, County of Franklin, State of Ohio on September 3, 1999, under the non-profit corporation laws of Ohio, shall be known as the Greek Olympic Society of Columbus, Ohio.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES OF CORPORATION

- 1) Promote fraternal fellowship and social interaction among all who embody Hellenic principals and traditions.
- Organize philanthropic projects on behalf of the Hellenic community in association with the Greek Orthodox Cathedral of Columbus.
- 3) Undertake athletic and educational activities to promote our heritage of the Olympic Ideals of "sound mind in a sound body" for members and for the youth of the Hellenic community.

ARTICLE III TERMS OF EXISTENCE

This chapter shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law or pursuant to Article XVIII herein.

ARTICLE IV INDEBTEDNESS

The highest amount of indebtness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself shall not exceed \$5,000 except for fund-raising events where debt is temporary or when expenditures are expressly approved by a majority of the members; provided, however, that such indebtedness shall never be greater than two-thirds of the value of the property of the corporation.

ARTICLE V REAL ESTATE

The amount in value of real estate which the corporation may hold shall not exceed five million dollars (\$5,000,000).

ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIPS CONFER NO PROPERTY RIGHTS & WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP

Any adult male of Greek ancestry, or any man who is married to a woman of Greek ancestry is eligible to become a member of the Greek Olympic Society. No member of this corporation shall, by virtue of his or her membership, hold, own or be vested with any property right or interst of any kind or character in or to any of the property or assets of the corporation. In the event of the dissolution of this corporation, regardless of the cause or manner of such dissolution, all of its property, property rights and assets of every kind and character shall be devoted first to the payment of the cost of dissolution and second to the payment of all of the debts then existing of this corporation. After the payment of all actual costs of dissolution and all the just debts of theis corporation, the entire balance of its assets of every kind and character shall be paid over pursuant to article XVIII herein

ARTICLE VII NEUTRALITY OF THE OLYMPIC SOCIETY

The Olympic Society shall remain apart and neutral from all political and ecclesiastical strifes and controversies.

ARTICLE VIII REGISTRATION

A majority of the 4 chief officers of the society may require that...

- 1) Every person wishing to become a member of the society shall submit a membership application to the society.
- 2) The application, accompanied by membership dues and other registration fees shall be completed in full and signed by the applicant.

3) All applications shall be recorded by the Secretary and referred by the President to the membership committee, which shall approve or reject the application by majority vote of the members present.

ARTICLE IX DUES

Membership dues shall be determined by the society and be paid in advance annually to the Secretary or Treasurer of the society. Member(s) currently enrolled as students at an institution of higher education, may be exempt from payment of annual dues.

ARTICLE X SUSPENSIONS

- 1) Any member who shall fail to pay his dues for a period exceeding two months after the due date shall be notified by the Secretary, and if he fails to pay his dues within one month after such notification, he shall forfeit his membership.
- 2) Every registration shall be considered a new registration and not a renewal.
- 3) Every registration shall be considered as taking effect as of the day the committee receives and approves the application.

ARTICLE XI RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MEMBERS

- 1) Every member shall receive written and/or electronic mail (e-mail) notice concerning all meetings of the society.
- 2) Every member shall have all rights, priveleges and benefits accorded by the society.
- 3) When a charge is brought against a member for any reason whatsoever, this member shall be entitled to an impartial trial.
- 4) The first duty of every member shall be to familiarize himself with the constitution and the by-laws of the society. In addition, each member shall:
 - a) Attend the meetings of the society and pay his dues regularly.

b) Notify the Secretary immediately of any change of address.

ARTICLE XII OUORUM

- 1) Ten members in good standing will constitute a quorum.
- 2) Every member shall recieve written and/or electronic mail (e-mail) notice concerning all meetings of the society.
- 3) Every member shall have all rights, privileges and benefits accorded by the society.

ARTICLE XIII CHAPTER OFFICERS - ELECTIONS AND INSTALLATION

- The administration of the society, the management of its property, the adherence to its Constitution and By Laws shall be assigned to the following offices: the President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, and the various committee chairmen. The President may appoint an Assistant Secretary and/or Treasurer.
- 2) The term of office of the officers shall be for a term of 2 years. They may be nominated and elected by secret ballot, by the members of the society in October of any election year. Ballots should be destroyed after they have been counted. A person must be a member of the society for at least one year in order to qualify for an elective office. No officer may be elected to the same office for more than two consecutive terms.
- 3) During the meeting for the nomination of officers, a three member auditing committee shall be elected which shall audit the books of the society and make a financial report annually.
- 4) Other Standing Committees shall be as follows:

a) Activities/ Social Committee

The basic efforts shall be to plan, organize, direct, and control the social functions of the Olympic Society. This effort shall include but not be limited to events for the monthly business meetings, theater events, family

outings, etc. Coordinate these efforts with the Athletic, Education, Membership and Public Relations committees.

b) Athletic Committee

Its purpose shall be to organize and plan various types of sports activities for the membership participation, either as a spectator or as a participant. The events shall include but not be linited to such activities as soccer, volleyball, tennis, baseball, football, basketball, miscellaneous athletic events, golf outings and other recreational programs.

c) Calling Committee

Responsible for verbal communication with the membership on meeting schedules and major program events sponsored by GOS.

d) Finance/Fund Raising Committee

The baseline effort is to provide various methods by which the Olympic Society can raise the monies to support and to appropriate funds for the selected activities agreed to by the membership.

e) Membership Committee

The effort shall be directed at both retention and expansion of the Membership to cover a wider selection of personnel commensurate with the status of the existing Greek Community make-up. Expand the base of the Olympic Society membership to be more representative of the current community.

f) Philanthropic Committee

Organize Philanthropic Projects on behalf of the Hellenic Community in association with the Greek Orthodox Cathedral of Columbus, Ohio.

g) Program/Education Committee

To plan programs which provide beneficial information of interest to the membership, plan special events to emphasize our Greek heritage, and to prepare programs that will assist our youth in furthering their education. Such efforts shall include obtaining speakers on a variety of subjects, coordinating with the Hellenic

Foundation on programs, sponsoring scholarship programs, and other events of interest to the membership.

h) Public Relations Committee

To be responsible for providing all the necessary data for release that will enhance the Society's image and position with both the Greek Community and the Greater Columbus area. Responsible for preparation of all data released to support events sponsored by the Society. COORDINATE with all other COMMITTEES to assure the maximum dissemination of information.

- 5) The president of the society shall appoint a nominating committee which shall obtain the names of each candidate. In the event of a tie vote, the ballot of the president shall decide the issue except regarding the election of the president in which case the V.P. shall decide.
- 6) Members who on the day of elections, are 2 months or more in arrears, as well as members against whom legal charges before the society are pending, shall not have the right to elect or to be elected to office.

ARTICLE XIV RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF THE SOCIETY OFFICERS

- 1) The President shall preside at all meetings and shall see that the Constitution and By Laws of the society are strictly adhered to; that every discussion is conducted in an orderly systematic manner; that the officers and the committee members perform their assigned duties faithfully. He shall countersign together with the Treasurer all vouchers and checks and together with the Secretary all official papers of the society. He shall call the meetings of the board members as well as of the society, and shall preside over them.
- 2) The Vice President shall represent the President in his absence. In case of resignation or death of President, the Vice President shall assume the duties of the President. In case of incompetence, death or resignation of both, the members of the society shall elect their successors at the next meeting.

- 3) The Treasurer shall be trustee of all moneys belonging to the society, whether paid by members or accruing from other sources and shall deposit same at a bank designated by the officers. He shall countersign together with the President or the Secretary all checks and vouchers (2 signatures required), and in general shall perform all the duties of his office. He shall submit monthly reports of the financial status of the society. He shall not pay any accounts exceeding \$1,000.00 unless previously approved by the President. Upon termination of his term, or upon resignation, he shall submit a true and accurate account and surrender to the society or to his successor all books, moneys, records and in general whatever belongs to the society.
- 4) The Secretary shall keep an exact record of the membership and the minutes of meetings, and shall conduct all correspondence. He shall collect the dues, and surrender same to the Treasurer. He shall report immediately to the President and the board the names of the new, suspended, resigned and deceased members. He shall mail or deliver to the President all applications for new members together with their accompanying registration fees.
- 5) The chairman of the Executive Committee (E.C.) shall work to further the interest of the society, to increase its membership, and in general to provide for the needs of the society. In addition, shall regularly attend the meetings of the society and board members, and in general, cooperate with the officers for the success of the society's objectives and the adherence to the Constitution and the By Laws.
- 6) The Executive Committee consisting of officers and the chairmen of standing and special committees shall meet regularly, at the discretion of the president and especially whenever necessary. Both the regular and the special meetings of the E.C. shall be called by the president, or when two thirds of the E.C. request such a meeting in writing. The E.C. shall have a quorum at all of its meetings, defined herein as at least a simple majority of its members being present. In case of a tie vote, the president shall decide the issue. If a quorum is not met, the E.C.will discuss but not act on any matter.

ARTICLE XV TRIAL OF MEMBERS

- 1) Whenever a member of the society causes grievances against another member or officer of the society, or if he deems that another member is guilty of infractions of the principals of the society, he shall file a written charge with the Secretary of the society. The president shall appoint a committee of impartial and qualified members to examine and study the charge and report their decision to him.
- 2) The defendant shall be given the right to state his case with the aid of witnesses, and then a majority vote of the committee will determine the guilt or non-guilt of the defendant.

ARTICLE XVI MEETINGS OF THE SOCIETY

- 1) After written notice to all members, the regular meetings of the society shall take place on the second Thursday of every month, except during July and August. The meetings of the different committee chairmen shall take place whenever the chairman determines to meet. Place and time being determined by the chairman.
- 2) Special meetings may be convened whenever the President deems necessary by written request of ten members, or two-thirds of the E.C.

ARTICLE XVII HONORARY MEMBERS AND BENEFACTORS

- A majority of the members may declare members or others who have offered or are offering exceptional services to the Society, honorary members or honorary presidents.
- 2) They may also declare those who offer monetary gifts to the society; donors; benefactors or great benefactors.
- 3) Those offering one thousand dollars or over shall be declared donors; those offering five thousand dollars, benefactors; and those offering over ten thousand dollars a great benefactor.

ARTICLE XVIII DISSOLUTION

 The society shall cease to exist when its membership is reduced to seven or less. In that event, all real and personal property shall dissolve to the Greek Orthodox Cathedral of Columbus, Ohio; or to such entity or persons as the society resonates.

ARTICLE XIX ORDER OF BUSINESS

- 1) The President calls the meetings to order.
- 2) Reading and approval of the minutes of the previous meetings.
- 3) Readings of correspondence.
- 4) Committee reports.
- 5) Treasurer's Reports.
- 6) Unfinished Business.
- 7) New Business.
- 8) Deliberation on improving the society in general.

ARTICLE XX FUTURE AMENDMENTS

1) This constitution and these by-laws shall govern the society until they are amended by any future vote of two-thirds of the members present at any meeting.

Our parish was chartered by the State of Ohio in 1910. There were about 30 Greek families in Columbus at the time and they wanted to form a parish even though they did not yet have a church building or priest. Their own church would not become a reality until March 27, 1922, when the first service was held on the Sunday of Annunciation. The parish has a very active youth ministry with a total of four youth groups, various religious and cultural educational programs that cater to the community's ever growing youth population (300 school-age children in 2003). In addition, the Cathedral sponsors the Sigma Epsilon Phi fratority which ministers to enrolled Greek Orthodox students at the Ohio State University. The beautiful Cathedral complex with it's elegant banquet hall was constructed just north of downtown Columbus in 1990 replacing the original facility built in 1922. The original Chapel is still a part of the Cathedral complex and is used for vespers services and special mid-week liturgies. The Cathedral won a 1989 City Beautiful Award for it's magnificent structure. It is situated at the SW corner of North High Street and Goodale across the street from the convention center and within easy access of all the major freeways. Tours are conducted throughout the year for various groups and organizations.
